New Business:

Beth DeJonghe met with Todd Warner who is our Loss Control Consultant with Michigan Municipal League who is our Worker's Comp Insurance Company. Everything is good.

Report from The Supervisor:

Tim Duby – Ordinance Officer: Tim is in Macon Township once every 2 weeks. The Department of Agriculture is taking control of complaints of too many animals away from the township and their ordinances. Talked about having a waiver for 4-H Animals.

Britton Hwy/Milwaukee Rd. Intersection: September 21, 2023 at 9am is the next Road Commission Meeting. The police have to finish the investigation and present it to the Road Commission Board. Dean

will ask for a study of the intersection and he will be at the meeting. The Road Commission has a traffic engineer on staff.

Dean is looking into a few severe weather sirens for the Township. There is one in Britton and one in Clinton. Ridgeway and Clinton think they should be able to activate them for us.

The Planning Commission approved the Solar Ordinance. It has to go to Region 2 and Lenawee County before it comes to the Township Board. Should be presented at the October Meeting.

COVID Funds Update:

Will vote on electrician at the next meeting to de-commission some wires in the boiler room.

Joe had a question on what Region 2 provides us. The provide help writing ordinances. Is there value in being a member of Region 2? Joe will review. Julia will provide him with the amount of dues we pay.
